

INFORMATION ON THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA PRIVACY POLICY

WHY THIS NOTICE

This document describes how the site manages the processing of user's personal data.

This is an information that is also provided pursuant to articles 12 and 13 of EU Regulation 679/2016 (hereinafter also referred to as "Regulation") and of Legislative Decree 196/2003, in a concise, transparent, intelligible and easily accessible form, with a simple and clear language, to those who interact with the services of the Domain Auction srl site, via vescovado n. 18, 15121 Alessandria (AL), VAT number: 02622890065, tel: 800-063-468, email: info@domainauction.srl, pec: domainauction@legalmail.it, accessible electronically from the address:

The information is provided only for the Site and not for other websites that may be consulted by the user through links on the Site.

THE DATA CONTROLLER

Following the consultation of this Site, data relating to identified or identifiable persons may be processed.

PURPOSE AND LEGAL BASIS (ART. 6 OF EU REGULATION 2016/679) OF THE PROCESSING

The data will be processed exclusively for the purpose of:

- 1) fulfilling legal obligations, national and / or international laws and regulations, provisions issued by Authorities or bodies to this authorized; the legal basis of the processing is that provided for in art. 6, paragraph 1, lett. c), EU Reg. 2016/679;
- 2) fulfill obligations towards the financial administration, the Public Administration in general and related bodies; the legal basis of the processing is that provided for in art. 6, paragraph 1, lett. c), EU Reg. 2016/679;

3) fulfill obligations dependent on the execution of pre-contractual measures that you have requested and on any subsequent contractual relationship, also deriving from the individual regulations; the legal basis of the processing is that provided for in art. 6, paragraph 1, lett. b), EU Reg. 2016/679.

4) proceed to send communications - through the processing of your personal contact data (by way of example but not limited to, email, mobile and / or fixed telephone number, also by sending Short Message Service, etc.) - which they are divided into the following categories:

a) those necessary for the purpose of fulfilling national and / or international legal obligations, regulations and regulations, also determined by obligations defined by the competent Authorities; the legal basis of the processing is that provided for in art. 6, paragraph 1, lett. c), EU Reg. 2016/679;

b) those necessary in order to fulfill obligations dependent on the execution of pre-contractual measures that you have requested and on any subsequent contractual relationship, also deriving from the individual regulations; the legal basis of the processing is that provided for in art. 6, paragraph 1, lett. b), EU Reg. 2016/679;

c) those aimed at promoting the owner's products and / or services, also different from those already purchased / used by the interested party. To receive this communications an express consent will be required (without prejudice to the hypothesis in which you have not previously given it), in any case you can at any time request the suspension of these communications through a suitable opt-out included in the communication; the legal basis of the processing is that provided for in art. 6, paragraph 1, lett. a), EU Reg. 2016/679.

5) proceed to send communications aimed at promoting other products and / or services of the Data Controller similar to those already purchased / used by the interested party (so-called "soft spamming"), in any case you can at any time request the suspension of such communications through suitable opt-out included in the communication; the legal basis of the processing is that provided for in art. 6, paragraph 1, lett. f), EU Reg. 2016/679.

6) ensure network and information security, i.e. the ability of a network or information system to withstand, at a given level of security, unexpected events or unlawful or malicious acts that compromise availability, the authenticity, integrity and confidentiality of the personal data stored or transmitted; the legal basis of the processing is that provided for in art. 6, paragraph 1, lett. c) and f), EU Reg. 2016/679.

7) carry out checks, with the exception of those relating to particular (ex art.9 EU Reg. 2016/679) or judicial (ex art.10 EU Reg. 2016/679), for the purpose of monitoring and preventing fraudulent payments, also by software systems that carry out an automated verification prior to the negotiation of services and / or products. It is understood that in the event that from these checks legal effects concerning the interested party arise, the same can express his opinion and reasonably contest the decision; the legal basis of the processing is that provided for in art. 6, paragraph 1, lett. c) and f), EU Reg. 2016/679 as well as art. 22, paragraph 2, lett. a), EU Reg. 2016/679.

8) carry out a check relating to the age and identity of the subjects who register on the Site platform in order to use the services and / or products, including verification of identity in order to provide assistance if the user loses or forget the login / password data for the services of the Site; the legal basis of the processing is that provided for in art. 6, paragraph 1, lett. c) and f), EU Reg. 2016/679.

9) carry out prevention and control activities relating to any abuses committed against the Site or any fraudulent activities carried out through the Site and / or its services; the legal basis of the processing is that provided for in art. 6, paragraph 1, lett. f), EU Reg. 2016/679.

10) carry out monitoring of the user's activity on the Site aimed exclusively at the assistance and maintenance of the Site; the legal basis of the processing is that provided for in art. 6, paragraph 1, lett. b) and f), EU Reg. 2016/679.

In particular, the following data are processed also through the use of own and third party web cookies:

- Navigation data:

The computer systems and software procedures acquire, during their normal operation, some personal data whose transmission is implicit in the use of Internet communication protocols.

This is information that is not collected to be associated with identified interested parties, but which by its very nature could, through processing and association with data held by third parties, allow users to be identified.

This category of data includes the IP addresses or domain names of the computers used by users who connect to the Site, the addresses in URI (Uniform Resource Identifier) notation of the requested resources, the time of the request, the method used in submitting the request to the server, the size of the file obtained in response, the numeric code indicating the status of the response given by the server (successful, error, etc.) and other parameters relating to the operating system and the user's computer environment.

These data are used for the sole purpose of obtaining anonymous statistical information on the use of the Site and to check its correct functioning and are deleted immediately after processing. The data could be used to ascertain responsibility in case of hypothetical computer crimes against the Site or committed through the Site and / or its services.

- Data provided voluntarily by the user:

The optional, explicit and voluntary sending of e-mails to the addresses indicated on this Site entails the subsequent acquisition of the sender's address, necessary to respond to requests, as well as any other personal data included in the message.

POSSIBLE RECIPIENTS OR POSSIBLE CATEGORIES OF RECIPIENTS OF PERSONAL DATA

Personal data may be communicated:

1) to subjects who can access the data pursuant to provisions of law or secondary or community legislation;

- 2) to third parties in the context of the activity deriving from contractual obligations;
- 3) to public and private entities, also following inspections and checks, dependent on the obligations deriving from contractual obligations;
- 4) to subjects to whom communication is required by law.

Individuals who can also access personal data: the Data Controller, the managers (as well as their supervisors), possibly appointed, and the internal collaborators and / or employees in charge of the processing.

WHERE APPLICABLE, THE INTENTION OF THE DATA CONTROLLER TO TRANSFER PERSONAL DATA TO A THIRD COUNTRY OR AN INTERNATIONAL ORGANIZATION AND THE EXISTENCE OR ABSENCE OF A COMMISSION ADEQUACY DECISION OR, IN THE EVENT OF THE TRANSFERS REFERRED TO IN ARTICLE 46 OR 47, OR IN ARTICLE 49, SECOND PARAGRAPH, THE REFERENCE TO APPROPRIATE WARRANTIES AND THE MEANS TO OBTAIN A COPY OF SUCH DATA OR THE PLACE WHERE THEY WERE MADE AVAILABLE

The data will not be transferred voluntarily to third countries outside the Union European.

That said, the information systems and those relating to the cookies more detailed at the related www.match.it/CookiePolicy-en.pdf which the Owner uses, may also be provided by companies whose servers are located in the USA: the USA are recipients of the adequacy decision by the European Commission and these companies (Google and Facebook), included in the list managed by the US Department of Commerce (with the status of " active ") guarantee to comply with the provisions of the EU-US Privacy Shields , thus guaranteeing the exercise of the rights deriving from the provisions of the Regulation.

THE RETENTION PERIOD OF PERSONAL DATA OR, IF NOT POSSIBLE, THE CRITERIA USED TO DETERMINE THIS PERIOD

Personal data will be kept for the execution of the services provided by the contract and other related activities. This is without prejudice in any case to the further conservation envisaged by the applicable legislation including that provided for by art. 2946 cod. civ.

EXISTENCE OF THE RIGHT OF THE INTERESTED TO ASK THE HOLDER THE ACCESS TO PERSONAL DATA AND CORRECTION OR CANCELLATION OF THEM OR LIMITATION OF TREATMENT THAT CONCERN HIM OR TO OBJECT TO PROCESSING THEM IN ADDITION TO THE RIGHT TO PORTABILITY OF DATA

In any moment it can be exercised, pursuant to articles 15 to 22 of EU Regulation no. 2016/679, the right to:

- 1) request confirmation of the existence or not of personal data;

- 2) obtain the correction and deletion of data;
- 3) obtain the limitation of data processing;
- 4) oppose the processing of data at any time;
- 5) obtain data portability, i.e. receive them, in a structured format, commonly used and readable by an automatic device, and transmit them to another data controller without hindrance.

THE RIGHT TO PROPOSE A COMPLAINT TO A SUPERVISORY AUTHORITY

At any time, you can lodge a complaint with the competent supervisory authority (Guarantor for the Protection of Personal Data), pursuant to art. 77 of the Regulation, if it is believed that the data processing is contrary to the legislation in force.

IF THE PERSONAL DATA COMMUNICATION IS A LEGAL OR CONTRACTUAL OBLIGATION OR A REQUIREMENT FOR THE CONCLUSION OF AN AGREEMENT, AND IF THE APPLICANT HAS ANY OBLIGATION TO PROVIDE PERSONAL INFORMATION AS WELL AS THE POSSIBLE CONSEQUENCES OF FAILURE OF SUCH DATA COMMUNICATION

For the purposes of treatment of which:

- numbers 1), 2), 4) lett. a), 6), 7), 8) of this information, the provision of data and the performance of the activity are necessary in order to fulfill a legal obligation, in the event of failure to provide and / or acceptance it will therefore not be possible to carry out the activities required for the conclusion and execution of the contract.
- at number 3), 4) lett. b) and 10) of this information, the provision of data and the performance of the activity are necessary in order to execute the contractual relationship and other related activities, in the event of failure to provide and / or acceptance it will therefore not be possible to carry out the activities - or part of them - required for the conclusion and execution of the contract. With regard to number 4) lett. b), without prejudice to any communications from the Data Controller, if the user wishes to object to the sending of communications, he / she can proceed with the termination of the existing contract with the Data Controller.
- at numbers 5) and 9) of this information, the provision of data and the performance of the activity are necessary in order to fulfill a legitimate interest of the Owner, in the event of failure to provide and / or acceptance it will therefore not be possible to carry out the activities - or part of them - required for the conclusion and execution of the contract. With regard to number 5), the right of the user to oppose at any time the sending of communications in the manner indicated in number 5) above remains in any case.
- at number 4) lett. c) of this information, consent to the processing is not necessary pursuant to current legislation, in any case the right of the user to oppose at any time to the sending of communications according to the methods indicated in number 4) lett. c) mentioned above.
